Health Status of Cases:



To be released from isolation a person must meet the following criteria:

- Be fever free for at least 72 hours (that is three full days of no fever without the use medicine that reduces fevers)

 -AND
- Have improvement of symptoms (for example, cough or shortness of breath have improved)


 -AND
- 3. At least 7 days have passed symptoms first began

Case Definitions:

<u>Probable</u>: includes individuals experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 who have either traveled to an area experiencing community spread or who are a contact of a laboratory confirmed case

<u>Confirmed</u>: individuals with laboratory confirmation of COVID-19
